COMMUNION STEWARDS

The Communion Stewards set up and tear down communion elements, place whole loaves of bread and grape juice in the chalice on the altar, fill communion cups with grape juice and pieces of bread and place on the trays. Small bags for used cups are placed in the pews Sunday morning before the service.

Two people are needed to set up for communion the first weekend of each month, two to three times a year. There are only two or three meetings a year. Communion Stewards are also needed for special services (Christmas Eve and Easter).
