Meals will be offered to the grieving family and friends of the deceased. These dinners are offered as a ministry by HEARTS of GRACE, but donations are accepted.

Each month two co-chairpersons agree to coordinate the meal preparation. Volunteers are also needed to help prepare the meal, serve the guests and clean up after. Workers in the kitchen are required to be vaccinated and must wear masks and use gloves while working. In addition there is often a need for baked goods and other food preparation which can be done in your home.
