

Kayak and Canoe Fellowship

About this Ministry: Spending fellowship time with others, together in God's wonderful creation, kayaking or canoeing in various areas of Western Pennsylvania. Typical locations we have paddled include: 1. Shenango River from Pymatuning State Park outside of Jamestown down to Greenville PA or if shorter distances are desired get out at Halfway Road. 2. Moraine State Park – various launching sites. 3. Lake Wilhelm – Goddard State Park – various launching sites. 4. Allegheny River from Emlenton to Parker, PA. 5. Cooks forest – Clarion River. 6. Presque Isle State Park in Erie – the lagoons. Other locations suggested by participants and within driving distance. Typically we go on Saturdays from mid mornings to later afternoons taking lunch with us when appropriate.

Ways you can help serve in this Ministry: Help with providing transportation of kayaks and canoes to various locations when needed. If you have a kayak or an extra one and are not planning on using it and you are willing to let someone borrow it, let us know – just need to have up to date permits and proper required equipment – paddles, life jackets, whistle, etc.
